- (c) From time to time the member of Board and Independent directors are updated regarding activities undertaken by various Division of the Company, business strategies, various policies, management structure etc. The Chief Financial Officer and the Company Secretary are jointly authorized for ensuring appropriate induction and training programmes for the directors including independent directors of the Company as and when requested by them for understanding any specific project, activity or process of the Company. The management provides such information and training either at the meeting of the Board of Directors or otherwise.
